Conservation Technician (Seasonal / Temporary)



Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District is seeking individuals to assist with water conservation programs and public engagement activities.

Job Summary: Assists with water conservation programs through the Utah Water Savers website, conducting residential site visits, educating the public on water conservation, irrigation systems, plant selection for Utah, and meeting program requirements.

Job Requirements: Two years of college-level classes in natural resources, conservation, environmental science, horticulture, or equivalent degree preferred. Must have a general knowledge of horticulture, landscape irrigation, and

water-efficient landscaping. Must also possess basic computer skills for word processing, spreadsheets, and web-based programs. Should possess excellent communication skills and be comfortable interacting with the public to promote awareness and interest in waterwise landscaping. Must be able to work outdoors in various weather conditions.

Wage: \$16.00-19.00/hour

Hours: Full-time positions (up to 40 hours/week) from March through October. Must be able to work a varied schedule, including some holidays and occasional events and classes held on Saturdays and evenings.
